



Adelaide Hills Adult Riders Policy 1.0 – Fall from Horse

Policy Title	Fall from Horse
Purpose of the Policy	<p>As an expression of the Adelaide Hills Adult riding clubs values we are committed to providing a safe environment for our members, day members, instructors and visitors.</p> <p>This policy sets out the Adelaide Hills Adult riding clubs core principles in relation to the identification, and management of falls; including falls from horseback.</p>
Policy	<p>Any rally attendee who falls from a horse before, during or after a rally where a hit to the head has occurred and the event has been witnessed is not permitted to partake in further riding for that day while on the rally grounds.</p> <p>An incident form is to be completed and signed by the rider and a committee member.</p> <p>If the rider does not hit their head or if it is not a witnessed fall then it is up to the rider in question with a committee member to ascertain if the rider is fit enough and consequently permitted to continue with the planned rally.</p> <p>Signed documentation to reflect this decision must be included in the incident report.</p> <p>Due to the health and safety of all members, in all instances when a rally attendee falls from their horse, the horse will be removed and placed in a safe area. If time permits the horse will be unsaddled and given water.</p>
